Hotel Liberty

If your travels take you to Offenburg in the German state of Baden-Württemberg, you'll do well to stay at Hotel Liberty. The name is telling: the hotel is housed in an old prison dating from 1845. When it closed its doors some 10 years ago, investors Christian and Dietmar Funk decided to turn it into a hotel. Its 38 rooms, restaurant, lobby, lounge and bar, revamped by design studio Knoblauch, give hint to the building's past, and there are some carefully refurbished reminders, such as the prison cell doors, that have been left intact. A life sentence here would be a joy. — MSS
